Awardees can either be a single entity or a partnership. The initiative must have been launched within 24 months of the current call for nominations. Examples include initiatives involving diversity, equity and inclusion (DEI); health equity; bridging the digital divide; workforce development; scholarships; food insecurity, etc.

Eligibility: Programs/individuals that have won within the past five years are ineligible for nominations.

Nomination: The attached nomination form and additional documentation must be completed for consideration. Only one nomination per program will be accepted. Nomination must be in only one category.

Criteria: Nominations will be reviewed based on the level of engagement and/or service that demonstrate the spirit of the awards.
